



FACULTY/NURSE SCIENTIST

The McGill University School of Nursing and McGill University Health Centre (MUHC) are inviting applications for fulltime faculty/nurse scientist appointments to contribute to the development of one or more programs of nursing research. The School of Nursing and the MUHC are part of a strong collaborative network of nursing excellence in Montreal in which nursing practice, education and research are fully integrated. The School offers two undergraduate and two master's programmes and a PhD programme in nursing. The Health Centre is recruiting a cadre of Nurse Scientists who are developing vibrant programmes of nursing research and collaborations with Advanced Practice Nurses and other disciplines. We are particularly interested in candidates who would be interested in an appointment that would be held jointly between the university and the health centre and enable the individual to commit up to 75% of their time to research and related activities. Interested applicants must have strong research preparation, be committed to building a programme based research career, and be strong candidates for external career awards.

The priority areas are for scientists building programmes of research related to nursing interventions and their outcomes with women, aging individuals, families, individuals living with chronic illness (particularly cancer, cardio-vascular conditions, and mental health conditions) or pain, or research related to improving the contexts in which nursing is practiced, eg nursing services research.
